WE DO OUR BEST TO MAKE THIS AN ENJOYABLE EVENT FOR ALL OF OUR VENDORS...EXHIBITING IS EASY:

- ALL Exhibits are located inside a 100' x 120' enclosed tent on the tennis courts-so all exhibits are out of the elements and off the dirt ground.
- Electricity is available on the perimeter of the tent.
- The tent is *secured* by Security Guards and assisted by Mule Security Systems during the off hours on Friday and Saturday evenings so exhibits are not tampered with and items do not have to brought back and forth daily.
- Prime spaces are located near entrances and at the end of aisles. Perimeter Prime have access to electricity: **Interior Prime** locations do not.
- Expo Sponsors receive additional "perks" such as 2 prime space booths, special sponsor signage, and more.
- Reservations for all Expo locations are required by March 31, 2019 to guarantee accurate signage & booth placement. Booths must be staffed at all times for maximum prospect interaction. Electricity availability cannot be quaranteed with reservations placed after March 31.
- Parking IS allowed in the Park on Friday ONLY. If setting up your exhibit on Saturday or Sunday, you may enter the Park between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. All vehicles must be out of the park by 8:00 a.m. For Saturday and Sunday, vendors are shuttled in after your exhibit is set-up. Easy, Convenient Shuttle Transportation begins running continuously at 8:00 a.m. and continues until 9:00 p.m. on Saturday and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. BEST-and recommended shuttle is from Westfield Meriden Mall.
