

The City of Meriden is pleased to announce the continuation of the Meriden Match Program! This program is designed to provide forgivable loans up to \$10,000 to commercial property owners and business owners located in Meriden's Transit Oriented Development (TOD) District and other eligible areas.

These loans, which are funded through the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, can be used to improve the exterior façades of downtown properties. 
