The job fair is co-hosted by Workforce Alliance, the American Jobs Center, the Midstate Chamber of Commerce and the Making Meriden Business Center.

This is one of a series of job fairs held this spring in South Central Connecticut to bring together jobseekers and employers in the region. Workforce Alliance runs four American Job Centers in New Haven and Middlesex Counties...including the one right at 85 West Main St., Meriden CT.

All are encouraged to come for the jobs and stay for the music. After the Job Fair, head over to the first concert in the Summer Music Series at the new amphitheater at the Meriden Green from 7-9 PM. The 14-acre Meriden Green is on State and Mill Streets and along Pratt Street.

Both the job fair and the park are easily accessible from the new Meriden train station, which features a pedestrian bridge that connects the downtown area and the Meriden Green.

Employer registration is \$300 and includes a box lunch and a reception following the job fair. Free event parking for employers and jobseekers will be provided at the public parking garage directly behind 24 Colony Street and at various sites in downtown Meriden. Food trucks are expected to be in the area for a portion of the day.
